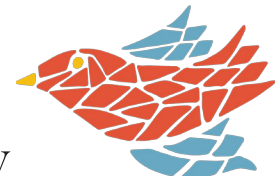

T.H.R.E.A.D. provides low-income refugees and other underemployed Tucsonans with the opportunity to sew all-cotton face masks at home, earning much-needed income while helping keep our community healthy.



To date, the project has given away more than 8,000 masks to healthcare workers, tribal members, and others across Southern Arizona.

All proceeds go directly to the sewers and to cover the cost of materials.
